First I resign unto Almighty God my soul hoping for salvation through the mediation of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. My body I trust to my trusty friend Executor of this my Last Will and Testament my body to be decently buried under his direction.

Item 1st I do appoint my true and trusty friend Antoine Krebs my executor to this my Last Will and Testament.

Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto Antoine Krebs all my real estate consisting of all my lands, messuages and tenements of which I am now possessed to have and to hold unto Antoine Krebs his heirs and assigns forever.

Item 3rd I give unto Antoine Krebs, Eli Krebs, Bazilo Krebs, Glauding Merrillens Jackson County and Poteto Krebs of Pensacola in West Florida all my stock of cattle, household and kitchen furniture and all my negro slaves together with all my personal property of whatsoever description I am now possessed to be equally divided share alike between them.

Item 4th I give unto my negro woman named Marie Frances and her children their freedom during their life times and request that my executor of this my Last Will and Testament (Mr. Antoine Krebs) will use his best effort to have them emancipated.
