1743 The year 1743, I, the Capuchin priest, missionary
apostolic, Cure (pastor) of Mobile, have baptized
Pierre with the ordinary ceremonies of holy church a boy
Krebs belonging to Hugo Ernestus Krebs and Marie Joseph LaPointe,
proceeding from a legitimate marriage. Godfather was
(sic) Pierre Millon, the godmother, Elizabeth (Illegible) who
have given him the name Pierre. The godfather has signed
with me, and the godmother has said she does not know how.
At Mobile the 29th of December, 1743.
